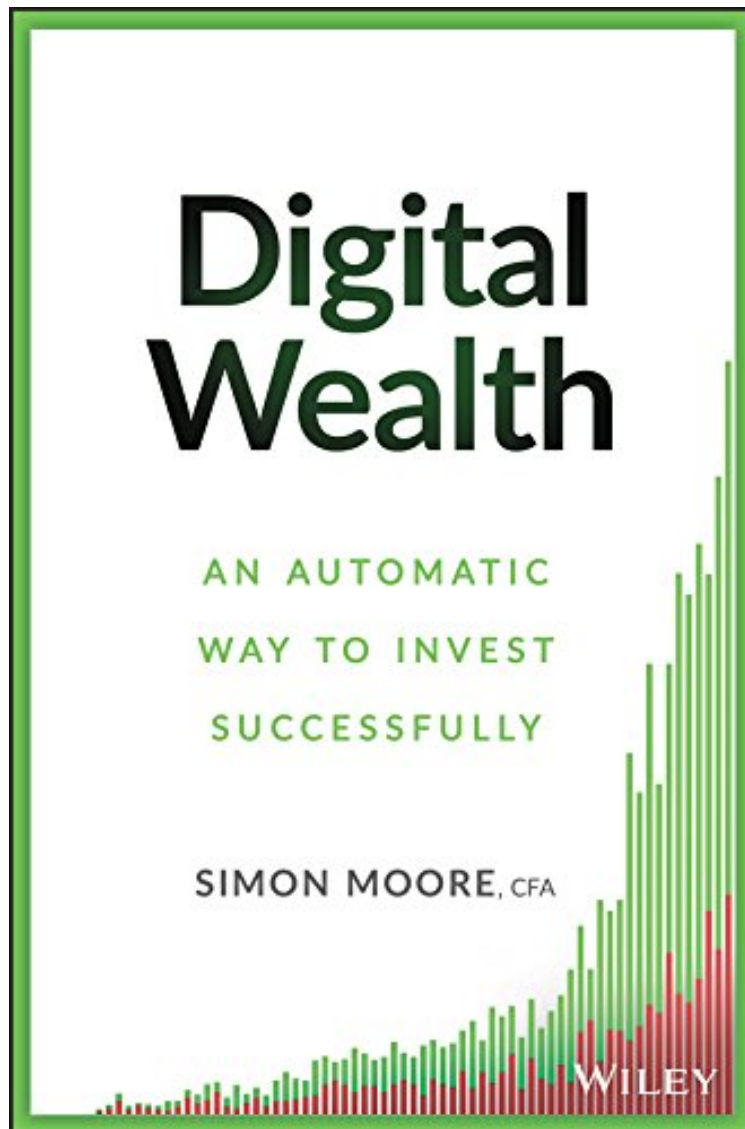

MasonsonMoorersquo;s book covers the basics of investing with an ETF focus because he believes that they offer

investors a number of key characteristics he finds useful: tax efficiency, diversification, and low-cost. He also prefers to use ETFs with rebalancing, small cap and value tilt, and dynamic asset allocation. On the other hand, he mentions that mutual funds tend to underperform their market benchmarks, as their fees and transaction costs negatively impact their performance. Additionally, he states that investors pay a premium for actively managed mutual funds that often times don't beat their benchmarks. The author has excluded a number of asset classes from his investing universe, as they were not consistent with his core investment portfolio. These include: illiquid securities, peer-to-peer lending, venture capital, private equity, cash, high yield debt, commodities, hedge funds and leveraged ETFs. However, he does recommend using international ETFs to smooth the portfolio returns. Moore suggests that stock market investing needs a long-term time horizon. Moreover, he advises investors to set up a continual saving and investing program to build wealth. He recommends that software be used to maintain a robust investment plan, but unfortunately doesn't provide too much detail on this subject. Moore does not provide specific ETF portfolio examples for investors with different risk tolerances or ages. Based on the author's investment experience, I was expecting to see full chapters focusing on specific software programs, automatic investment approaches, rule-based algorithms and robo-advisors, but there were none. All these subjects were too lightly touched on. Therefore, the connection of the book's contents to the title of the book was not readily apparent to me. The information he does provide is interesting and informative and novice investors would find it useful. This book is more of a generic overview than a comprehensive review of the topics discussed. Overall, much of the information provided in the book is not new, but it is presented in an easy-to-read, clear-cut manner, in a number of cases with examples. A more thorough explanation of the key concepts of the book would have been appreciated, so the reader could understand the next upcoming iteration in the area of self-directed investment management and selection. 1 of 1 people found the following review helpful.
