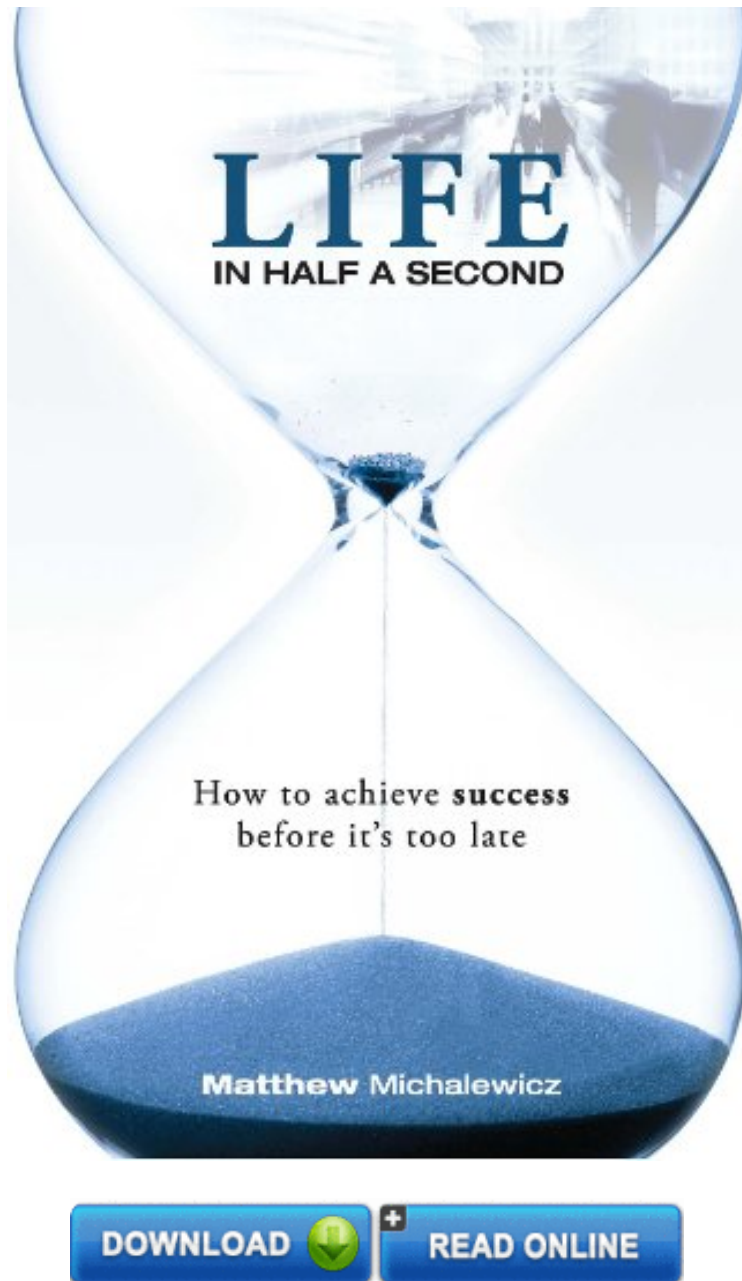

The author advises the reader to share personal goals with others -- well I just did. Also, I stopped swimming at the community pool that is 86 F where I'm the fastest one in the pool and started swimming at the swim team the university pool which is 75 F and where the swim team regularly works out. I also am seeking knowledge by paying for coaching and underwater video-analysis of my stroke. This last step was always missing -- knowledge. I figured that if I worked out hard by myself I could achieve my goals. Now I'm on my way. If you're coming to the 2014 Gulf Coast Senior games and swimming the 50-freestyle in the 50-55 age group -- you better bring it.
