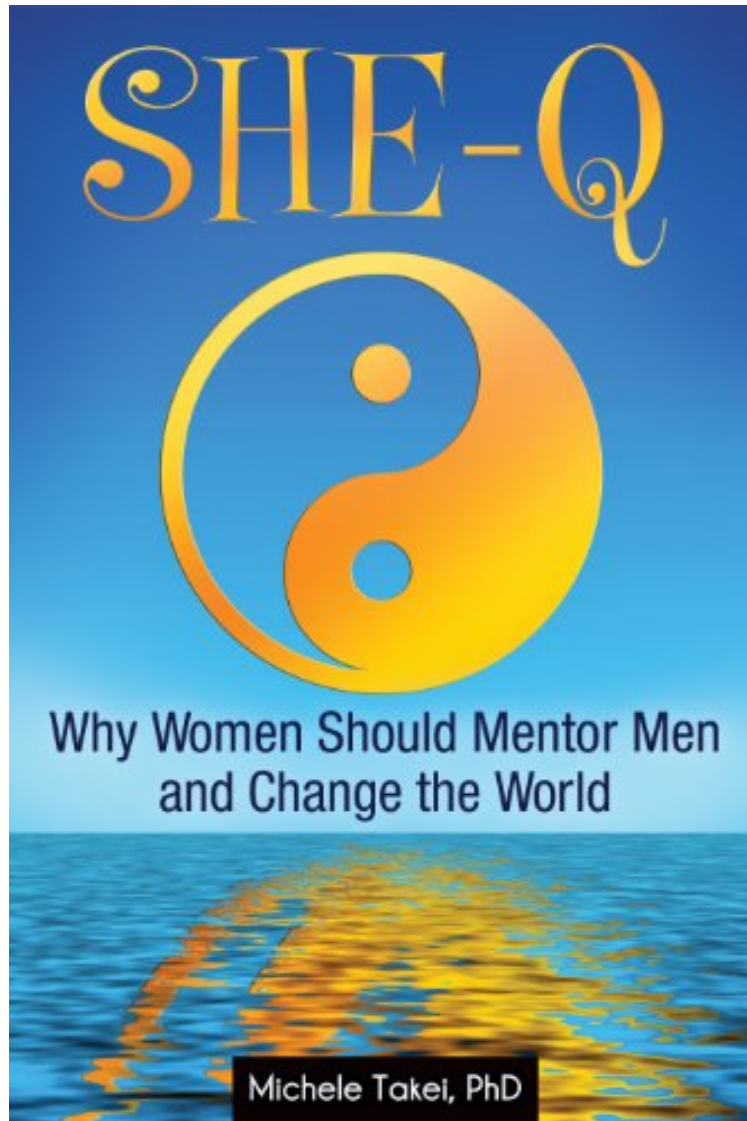

Globally, she gives a convincing perspective of how much better the world would be if men and women were to embrace both the feminine and masculine qualities of people in balance. Near the end of the book she states "A balanced world welcomes each child, who represents not only a welcome addition to the family, but also a living symbol of ongoing life and spiritual immortality. The offspring or child is most valued and most protected and nurtured in every species, for there is nothing of greater value. Nothing. In the new story, both parents nurture the child. Things return to their proper balance. Both adults put aside their sense of self for a greater purpose until the child matures and gains knowledge and ability." And in another section, "There can be a new spiritual context for tomorrow's world. We can start restoring balance and perhaps the best way to start is within each relationship. In personal relationships, women hunger for an I-thou relationship with their partners. At the same time, the I-thou relationship - the recognition that a spark of divinity in one person recognizes and honors the spark of divinity within the other - can only benefit the world. Imagine a world where each person honors the sacredness of the other."
